**VENUS
Study**

We are looking for women with gynecologic cancer to take part in a research study called VENUS.



The purpose of the VENUS study is to learn more about gynecologic cancer to:

- Detect gynecologic cancer sooner
- Find better treatments



The study will gather information about biomarkers in your cancer. Biomarkers are things that can be measured in blood, other fluids and tissues.

Biomarkers are used to:

- Detect cancer
- Tell doctors if a treatment for cancer is working



Taking part in the study involves letting the study team collect:

- Tumour tissue samples
- Blood samples
- Other samples

If you have high grade serous ovarian cancer (HGSOC), you will not be able to take part in the VENUS study. But you may be able to take part in the BioDiva study.
